

Drogheda Camino

In recent months a new camino route has opened in county Louth. It is a 25km looped walk starting at St. Peter's Church in the centre of the town and goes Crosses the Celtic Monasterboice. The route is a mixture of riverside, greenway, wood paths, quiet country roads,



canal path and green fields on its route from Drogheda to Old Mellifont Abbey and back. The Boyne Valley Camino is part of the Celtic Camino from Ireland, which can be completed by undertaking the famous Camino of Santiago de Compostela (75km) in Spain.
