



On the following Saturday evening of June 8th the 7pm Vigil Mass will be offered for those interred in St. Declan's Cemetery with blessing of the graves afterwards at 8.30pm. The graves in Donaghmore will be blessed at 10.45am following the Sunday morning Mass of June 2nd in Donaghmore church. Devotions in Greenogue will follow at 11.30am.
