#### First 'Do This In Memory' Mass



This Sunday is the first of six 'Do This In Memory' Mass Weekends in our parish. 'Do This In Memory' is the name given to the parish 1st Communion preparatory

program that encourages the home, school and parish to work together in a positive way to pass on faith. We welcome the families preparing for the sacrament in May 2025. This year, thanks to the efforts of the Parish Pastoral Assembly, parents are getting more involved in the 'Do This In Memory' Masses. For this first Mass of the program the children have been learning about blessing themselves at the beginning and end of Mass. They also are learning from their parents how to cross their hands when coming up at communion time to ask the priest or Eucharistic Minister for a blessing.

A new child friendly board has been erected in Ashbourne Church for children taking part in the 'Do This In Memory' preparatory program. We thank the parents of children for 1st Communion from St. Mary's School who helped decorate this month's 'Sacred Space'. Members of the PPA

also created the first monthly parental enewsletter to support 1st Communion parents. Discussion also took place around the launch of the new parish website in December, and the group began reflection on how to reach out to The seembly young Catholics in our parish.
