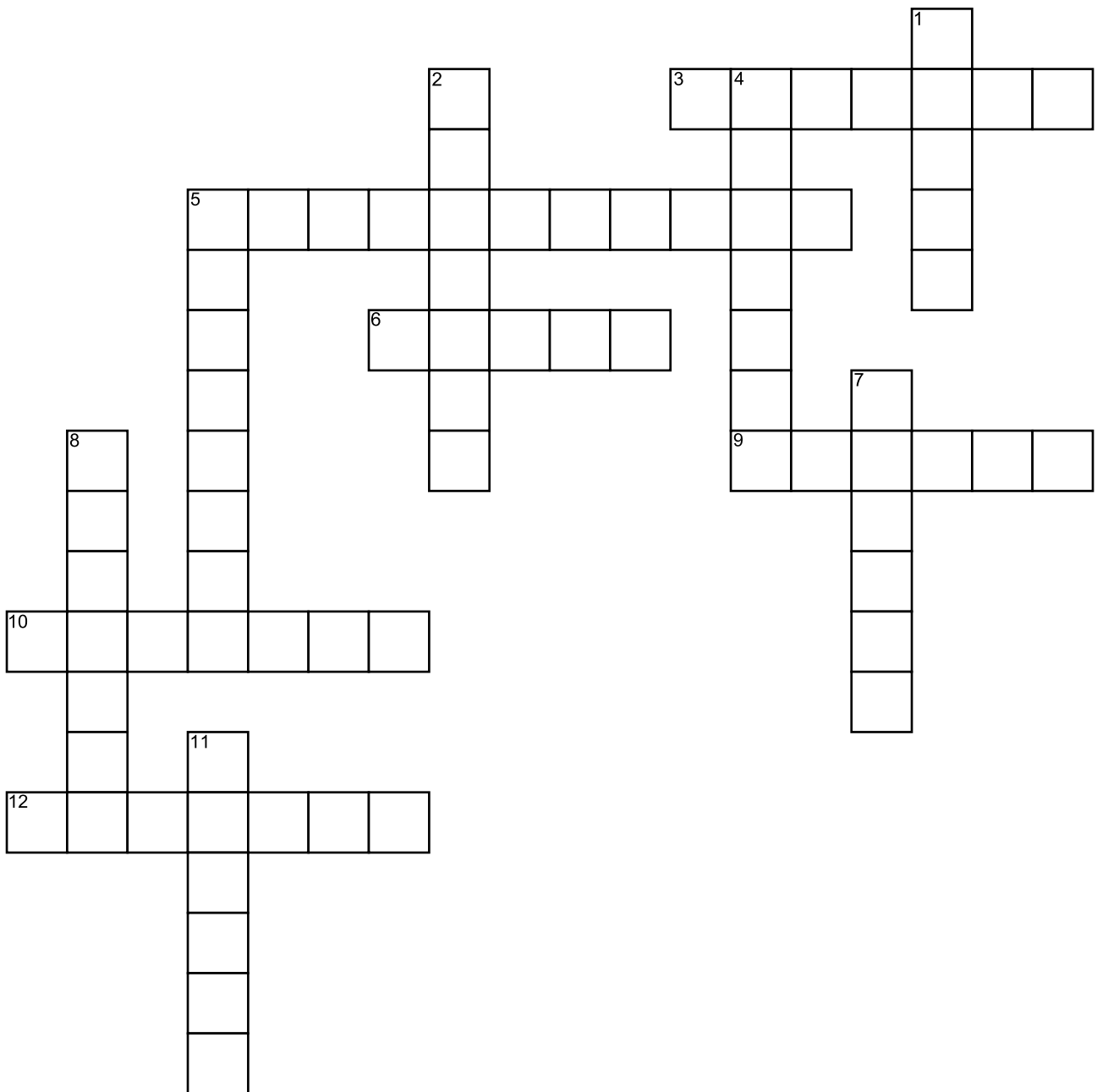


Basic Terms Crossword Puzzle



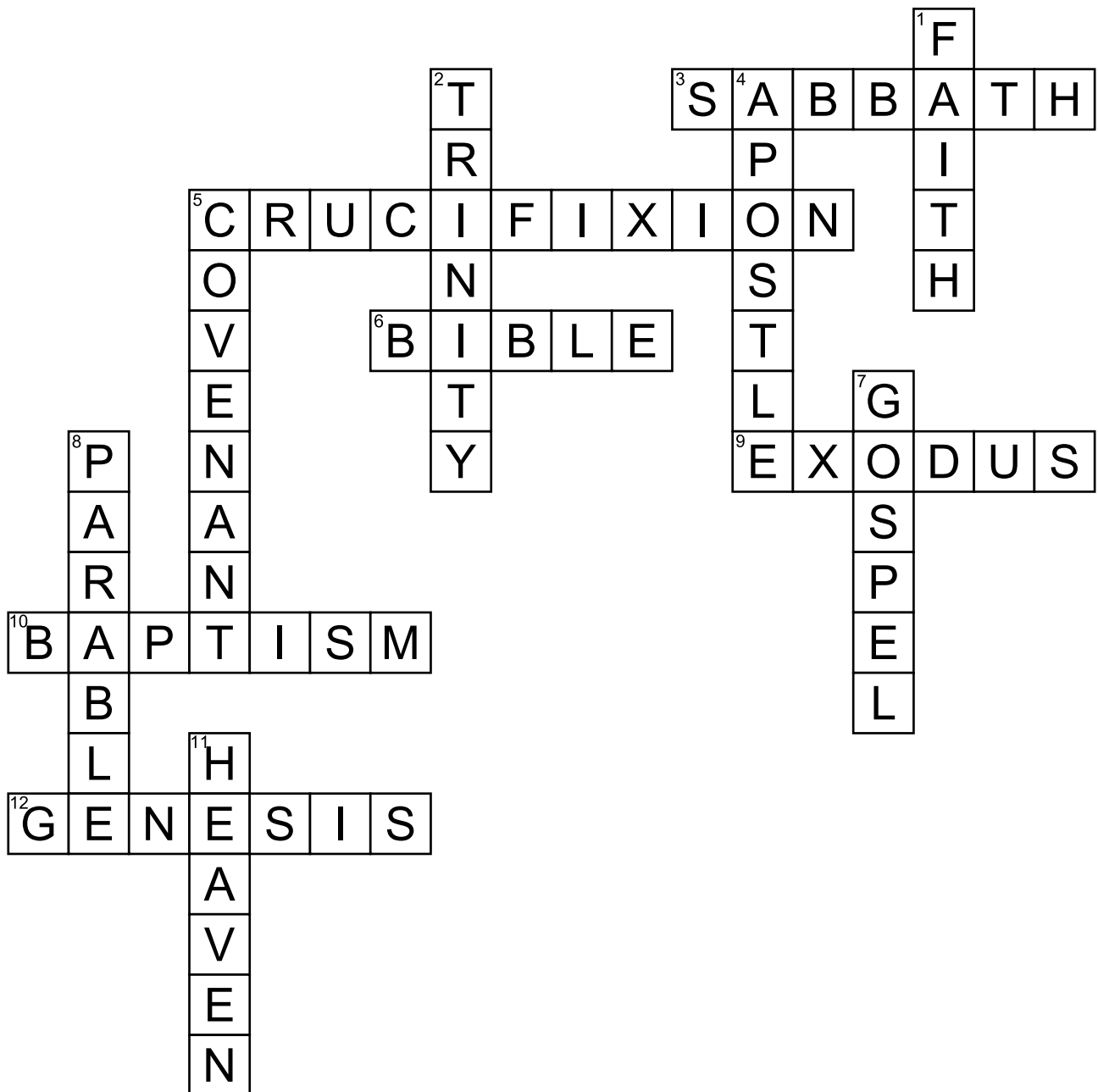
