

Bethlehem: Birthplace of Jesus Christ, fulfilling the prophecy of the Messiah's birth.

Nazareth: Hometown of Jesus, where he grew up and began his ministry.

Jericho: Ancient city where the walls fell after Joshua's army marched around them.

Egypt: Place of refuge for the Holy Family when they fled from King Herod's persecution.

Calvary: The site of Jesus's crucifixion, also known as Golgotha.

Capernaum: Town where Jesus performed many miracles and taught in the synagogue.

Galilee: Region where Jesus conducted much of his ministry, including many miracles and teachings.

Bethany: Village where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead and stayed before entering Jerusalem.

Gethsemane: Garden where Jesus prayed and was arrested the night before his crucifixion.

Judaea: The region encompassing Jerusalemand surrounding areas, central to Jesus's ministry.

Jordan: River where Jesus was baptised by John the Baptist.

Hebron: City where Abraham settled and where David was anointed king.

Damascus: City where Saul (Paul) was converted to Christianity on the road to Damascus.

Nineveh: City where the prophet Jonah was sent to preach repentance.

Babylon: City representing the place of exile for the Israelites and symbol of oppression.

Eden: The paradise where Adam and Eve lived before the Fall.
