

Anne: According to tradition is said to be the mother of the Virgin Mary and grandmother of Jesus.

Barnabas: An early Christian missionary and follower of Paul.

Joachim: According to tradition is said to be the father of the Virgin Mary and grandfather of Jesus.

James: Known as James the Just. He was a leader of the early Christian church in Jerusalem.

Joseph: The adoptive father of Jesus and husband of Mary. The patron saint of workers and the universal Church.

John: Known as John the Baptist. The forerunner of Jesus. baptised people in the Jordan River and preached repentance.

Mary: The mother of Jesus. Honored as the Mother of God and the Queen of Heaven.

Mary: Devoted follower of Jesus, is venerated for being the first to witness and announce His resurrection.

Matthias: Chosen to replace Judas Iscariot, Saint Matthias was one of the twelve apostles and preached the Gospel.

Paul: Originally named Saul, Saint Paul was a key figure in the early Church and authored many New Testament letters.

Philip: One of the seven deacons chosen by the apostles. He spread the Gospel and performed miracles in Samaria.

Silas: A follower of Paul on missionary journeys, Saint Silas is known for his role in spreading Christianity.

Stephen: The first Christian martyr who died for his faith and is the patron saint of deacons.

Timothy: A disciple of Paul and an early Christian leader, Saint Timothy is known for his pastoral care and leadership.

Titus: A disciple of Paul and early Christian leader, Saint Titus is known for his role in organising the early Church.

Veronica: According to tradition, Saint Veronica wiped the face of Jesus on the way to his crucifixion.
