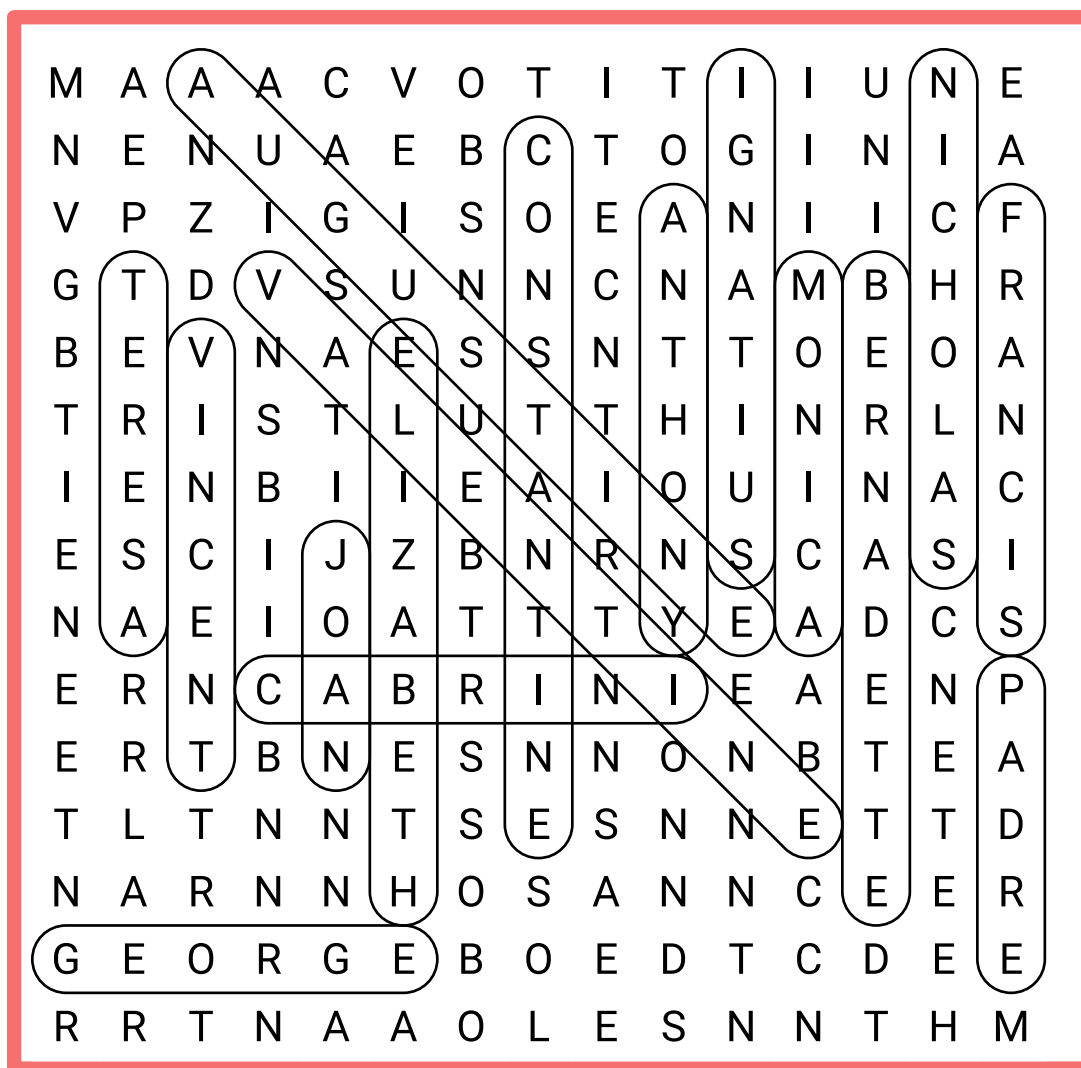

- Anthony:** Saint Anthony of Padua. Known for his preaching and devotion to the poor and sick.
- Augustine:** Saint Augustine of Hippo. Theologian and philosopher. Influenced Christian thought.
- Bernadette:** Saint Bernadette Soubirous. Saw visions of Holy Mary Mother of Jesus at Lourdes.
- Cabrini:** Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini. Founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.
- Constantine:** Roman emperor Constantine. Played a crucial role in the legalisation of Christianity.
- Elizabeth:** Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton. Established the first Catholic girls' school in the United States.
- Francis:** Saint Francis of Assisi founded the Franciscan order. Known for love of nature and animals.
- George:** Saint George. Often depicted slaying a dragon. Venerated as a protector of soldiers.
- Ignatius:** Saint Ignatius of Loyola founded the Jesuit order and wrote the Spiritual Exercises.
- Joan:** Saint Joan of Arc. Led her country's army to victories inspired by divine visions.
- Monica:** Saint Monica. Known for her devout prayers in converting her son, Saint Augustine.
- Nicholas:** Saint Nicholas. Known for his generosity. Inspiration for the modern-day Santa Claus.
- Padre:** Saint Pio of Pietrelcina, commonly known as Padre Pio, for his stigmata, and miracles.
- Teresa:** Saint Mother Teresa. Dedicated to serving the poor in Calcutta and around the world.
- Valentine:** Saint Valentine. Associated with love and is celebrated on February 14th.
- Vincent:** Saint Vincent de Paul founded the Vincentians. Known for his charitable work with the poor.
