


The 12 Apostles Crossword Puzzle




Across

- [3] Son of Zebedee and brother of John.
- [6] Peter's brother, also one of the first apostles.
- [7] Also called Didymus, known for doubting Jesus' resurrection until he saw Him.
- [8] The apostle who betrayed Jesus.
- [9] Also known as Nathaniel, one of the Twelve Apostles.
- [12] A former tax collector, also known as Levi.

Down

- [1] Son of Alphaeus, one of the Twelve Apostles.
- [2] One of the Twelve Apostles, known for his zeal.
- **[4]** Brother of James, also called the "Beloved Disciple."
- [5] One of the Twelve Apostles, known for bringing Nathaniel to Jesus.
- [10] Also known as Judas son of James, or Lebbaeus.
- [11] One of the first apostles called by Jesus, also known as Simon.

- [3] Ephesus: A major city in Asia Minor where Paul established a church.
- [6] Cana: The town where Jesus performed his first miracle of turning water into wine.
- [7] Nazareth: The town where Jesus grew up.
- [8] Egypt: The country where the Israelites were enslaved before the Exodus.
- [9] Gethsemane: The garden where Jesus prayed before His arrest.
- [12] Rome: The capital of the Roman Empire.

- [1] Jericho: The city where the walls fell after Joshua's army marched around it.
- [2] Jordan: The river where Jesus was baptised by John the Baptist.
- [4] Capernaum: A town on the Sea of Galilee where Jesus often taught.
- [5] Bethlehem: The birthplace of Jesus Christ.
- [10] Damascus: The city where Paul was converted to Christianity.
- [11] Eden: The paradise garden where Adam and Eve lived before their fall, according to the Bible.
