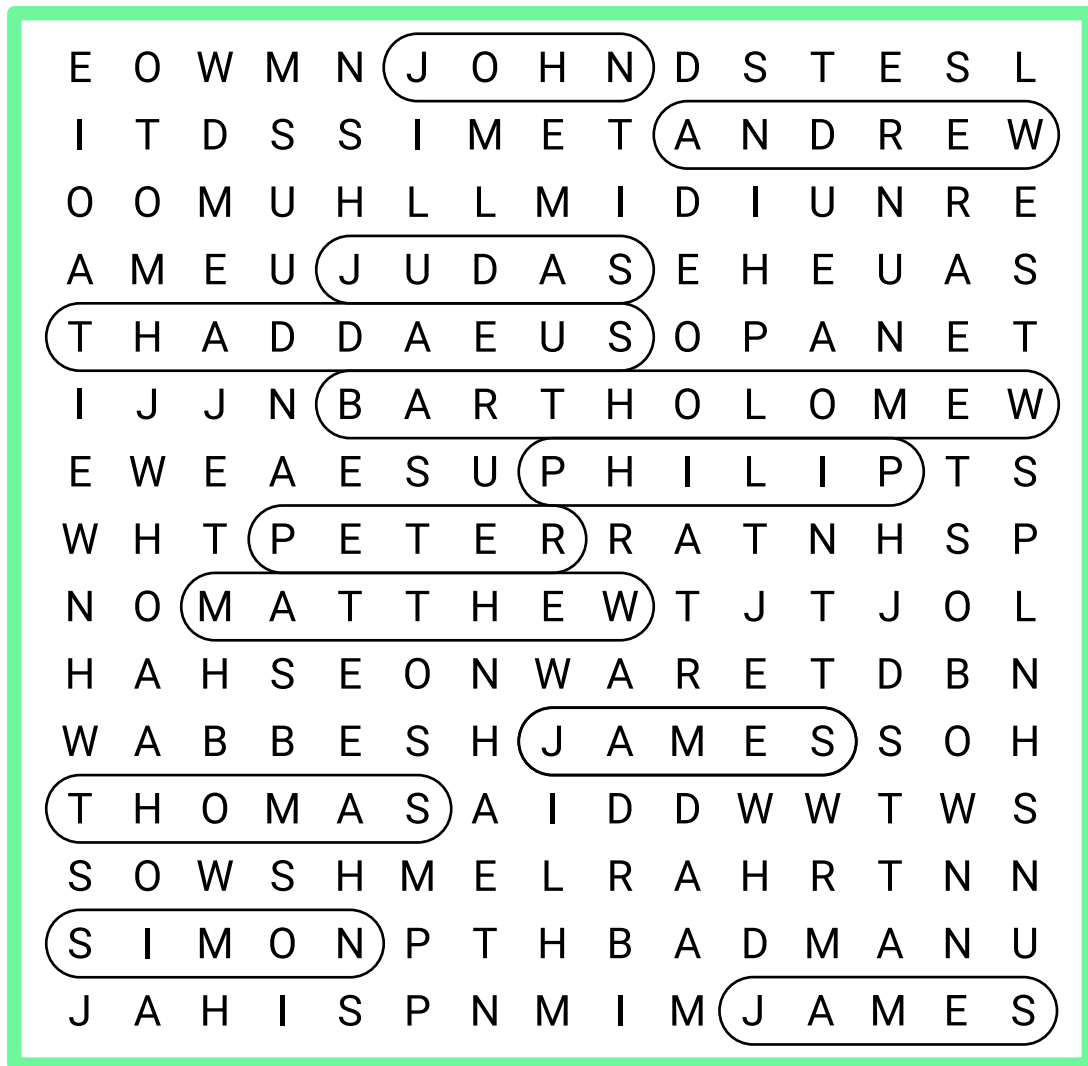

The 12 Apostles Word Search (Easy)



Peter: Leader of the apostles. The first pope and was given the keys to the kingdom of heaven by Jesus. A fisherman.

Andrew: Peter's brother and one of the first disciples called by Jesus. A fisherman.

James the Greater: The son of Zebedee and brother of John.

John: The brother of James, and author of the Gospel of John, three epistles, and the Book of Revelation.

Philip: Philip brought Nathanael (Bartholomew) to Jesus and played a key role in the early Church.

Bartholomew (Nathanael): Was brought to Jesus by Philip and is associated with missionary work in Armenia.

Matthew: A former tax collector. Authored the Gospel of Matthew and emphasised Jesus's role as the Messiah.

Thomas: Also known as Didymus. Doubted Jesus's resurrection until he saw Him, hence the term "Doubting Thomas."

James the Lesser: The son of Alphaeus. Known for his leadership in the early Church.

Thaddeus: Jude/Judas Thaddeus/Lebbaeus. Author of the Epistle of Jude. Patron saint of lost causes.

Simon the Zealot: Known for his zeal. Was a member of a group called Zealots.

Judas Iscariot: The apostle who betrayed Jesus for thirty pieces of silver, leading to Jesus's arrest and crucifixion
